## Introduction

This document contains historic census information for our Jordan, Scholdberg and Steward ancestors and is available on [Our Jordan Family Web Pages](#) as part of our Jordan family history.

For ease of use, the above [Table of Contents](#) includes active links along with a simplified genealogy chart to assist in selecting items of interest. Merely touch the line or page number to move to a section of interest.

Following are *Jordan Family Census Records* for three family surnames that led to our current Jordans all of whom are part of *The Jordan Story*. The *Census Records* begin with the John Isaac and Sarah Steward Family of Poplar, England and include some of their descendants; one branch of which led to the Scholdbergs and Jordans of Poplar and later the Jordans of Chicago.

Census Records were obtained from a number of sources and these are generally indicated in the notes section following each transcribed census record.

The census and thus census records are organized around households and thus the various census records that are indexed in the above *Table of Contents* are titled by the Head of Household and their spouse. Census records for an individual when younger are generally with their parent's.

Spellings of names and places vary for different records and sometimes individuals changed some part of their names or used nicknames or abbreviations. In the transcriptions that follows, the names are transcribed as they were recorded in the original record source.

In order to help preserve our Jordan family history and to make that history more widely available, [Our Jordan Family Web Pages](#) was created in the early years of the 21st century.

While quite successful in its goals, it became clear with the passage of time, that a web site with many hundreds of pages was not easy to print or to electronically download. Thus in the later part of the first decade of the 21st century, I began to compile various categories of information such as *Jordan Family Address Lists*, *Jordan Family Census Records*, *Jordan Genealogy Source Records*, *Oscar Scholdberg's Voyages*, *Recollections of the Jordans and the Jordan Stories* into pdf documents.

Such pdf files will make it easier to download files for preservation on our many computers and they will also allow much easier printing of pages and for studied analysis as desired. As part of this effort, a [Jordan PDF Downloads](#) web page was created. From this page, all currently available pdf's from [Our Jordan Family Web Pages](#) can be accessed.

You are encouraged to download the various Jordan, Scholdberg, and Steward pdf files, not only for your own study but to also help preserve

for future generations hard to obtain data and information about our common Jordan, Scholdberg and Steward origins and history. Files are updated every once in a while, and checking about once a year is a reasonable frequency. Version dates are shown at the beginning of the [Table of Contents](#).

You may have noted that the current file is quite lengthy and contains information for not only the Jordans but also the Stewards and Scholdbergs. While it might have made sense to focus this document on one family or a family line with the same surname, my worry was that there would have been a proliferation of pdf files. That is, many pdf files instead of just one for the *Jordan, Scholdberg, and Steward Census Records*. Many scattered files and associated updates would make it harder for all of us to find and help preserve our Jordan family history. Thus all have been placed within the current file.

**Elizabeth Holloway** between January 1825 and January 1830 in either Poplar or St. Albans, England; married Joseph John Steward on on 11 June 1848 at St. Mary's Stratford Bow in Bow, England; to America on 18 August 1893 and then settled in Chicago; to Madison, Wisconsin about 1907; died 12 April 1908 in Verona, Wisconsin ✓

- i. **Elizabeth Priscilla Holloway Steward** born as Elizabeth Priscilla Holloway 27 February 1847 at the Poplar Union Workhouse, Poplar, England; married Knut Oscar Scholdberg on 24 May 1867 at St. Mary's Stratford Bow in Bow, England; after Knut Oscar Scholdberg died, she married James Jordan ✓

**Knut Oscar Schöldberg** born 13 January 1837 in Jämshög, Blekinge, Sweden; christened 17 January 1837 in Jämshög, Blekinge, Sweden; married Elizabeth Priscilla Holloway Steward on 24 May 1867 at St. Mary's Stratford Bow in Bow, England; died 15 November 1875 in Alexandria, Egypt ✓

**Elizabeth Priscilla Holloway Steward Schöldberg** married James Jordan on 16 November 1876 at St. Mary's Stratford Bow in Bow, England after Knut Oscar Scholdberg died (see above); to America on 18 August 1893 and then settled in Chicago; temporarily to Madison about 1907-1908, then returned to Chicago; died on 22 April 1931 in Chicago ✓

**James Jordan** born about 1845, probably in England; married Elizabeth Priscilla Scholdberg on 16 November 1876 at St. Mary's Stratford Bow in Bow, England; date and place of death unknown; father's name was John Jordan, a farmer in 1876

- ii. **Joseph John Steward** born 18 June 1849 Poplar, England; immigrated to San Francisco; death date unknown

- v. **[Robert] Henry Steward** born between 22 March 1858 in Poplar, England; married Mary Ann Smith on 8 March 1881 at St. Jude in Bethnal Green, England; death date unknown ✓

III. **John Isaac Steward** born 2 July 1828 in Poplar, England; married Jane Ann Hooper on 5 June 1854 at All Saints in Poplar, England; possibly died about 1Q1865

IV. **Mary Ann Steward** born 2 May 1832 in Poplar, England

V. **Elizabeth Sally** Steward born 3 October 1836 in Poplar, England

**Notes**

1. A January 2008 search of the Free BMD index showed a Sarah Steward who died in Poplar in 2Q1851, volume 2, page 230. This would appear to be our Sarah Steward as it is the only Sarah Steward death in Poplar from 1841 to 1910.
2. A January 2008 search of the Free BMD index showed: a) John Steward who died in Poplar in 1Q1865, volume 1c, page 562, and b) John Steward, age 80 who died in Poplar in 3Q1871, volume 1c, page 458. The 80 year old, born about 1791 possibly is our John Isaac Steward. He should also be listed in the 1861 and 1871 census. It might also be that the John Steward who died in 1865 was married to Jane. He would have been about age 35 if this is so.
3. A January 2008 search of the Free BMD index showed John Isaac Steward married Jane Ann Hooper 2Q1854, volume 1c, page 1022. The Church record shows that it was on 5 June 1854.
4. Three variants have now been seen on Robert Steward's middle name: Melvin, Melville, and Melbourne. It is not clear if he changed it or if there were misunderstandings when it was written.

## **John and Sarah Steward's Census Records**

To date, the earliest known Stewards ascending from our Scholdberg and Jordan lines are John Steward and Sarah Richman. They married in Poplar, England on 26 November 1820 at St Dunstan in Stepney, County of Middlesex in England. Stepney is in the borough of Tower Hamlets. At the time or shortly thereafter they lived in the nearby town of Poplar and remained there for the duration for their lives.

John's destiny is unknown and while he has been searched for with and without Sarah for 1861 and also with relatives, no 1861 record Census record for John and Sarah Steward has been found. However, a blank record, linked above has been inserted should one be found.

## 1841 Census Notes

An attempt has been made to reproduce all data exactly as it is on the original census record; some column heading wording changes have been made for brevity.

1. The above census data was found in a May 2006 search by Diane Cuseil.
2. The data is from HO 107/702/412, Folio 13, page 21
3. It is believed that the John and Sarah Steward in this 1841 Census record are the parents of my Joseph John Steward. From Joseph John Steward's Marriage Registration in 1848 he indicated that his father's name was John Isaac Steward, a shipwright, a perfect occupation match. In addition other data indicates that Joseph John Steward was born between 1824 and 1826 thus matching the age of 15 for the 1841 census. Finally, though it might be co-incidence, the Joseph listed above had a daughter named Elizabeth the same as his sister. However it is more likely she was named after her mother Elizabeth Holloway.
4. There is also good linkage to the 1851 Census Record.

## 1851 Census Notes

An attempt has been made to reproduce all data exactly as it is on the original census record; some column heading wording changes have been made for brevity.

1. The above census data was found in a May 2006 search by Diane Cuseil.
2. The data is from HO 107/1556, Folio 632, page 25
3. It is believed that the John and Sarah Stewart [d] family above in the 1851 Census is the same as the one, also shown above, for the 1841 Census. In particular, names, ages, and occupations match. Son Joseph Stewart was in the 1841 family, but he was married by 1851 and had his own household. Daughter Elizabeth is missing. She would have been about 15 years old. It is possible that she died or perhaps married.
4. A check of Free BMD for deaths for John, Sarah, and Elizabeth Stewards in Poplar yielded the following results:
  - a) Sarah Stewart, June quarter 1851, the only Sarah Stewart death in Poplar from 1841 to 1910.
  - b) John Stewart March quarter 1865
  - c) Elizabeth Stewart December quarter 1864
5. This death data suggests that the Sarah Stewart in the above 1851 Census record probably died later in 1851. John Stewart appears to have lived on and may yet be found in the 1861 Census, although it is possible that the 1865 Stewart death is his son. It is unknown whether the Elizabeth Stewart who died in 1864 was their child and was somehow missed in the 1851 Census. On the other hand, it is possible John and Sarah's Elizabeth was married by 1851.

## 1861 Census Notes

An attempt has been made to reproduce all data exactly as it is on the original census record; some column heading wording changes have been made for brevity.

1. No entry for John and Sarah Steward has been found in the 1861 Census.
2. A check of Free BMD for deaths for John, Sarah, and Elizabeth Stewards in Poplar yielded the following results:
  - a) Sarah Steward, June quarter 1851, the only Sarah Steward death in Poplar from 1841 to 1910.
  - b) John Steward March quarter 1865
  - c) Elizabeth Steward December quarter 1864
3. This death data suggests that the Sarah Steward in the above 1851 Census record probably died in 1851. John Steward appears to have lived on and may yet be found in the 1861 Census, although it is possible that the 1865 Steward death is his son. It is unknown whether the Elizabeth Steward who died in 1864 was their child and somehow was missed in the 1851 Census.

## **Robert and Jemima Steward's Census Records**

Robert Melville Steward was born about 1821 in either Stepney or Poplar England. His parents were John and Sarah Steward. Robert Steward does not directly ascend from our Scholdberg and Jordan lines, but he is the older brother of Joseph John Steward who does. Robert Melville Steward married Jemima Mary Miller on 27 April 1845 at St. Anne's, Limehouse, County of Middlesex, England. It was hoped that for 1861 there might be some other family members. However, there was none.

For the 1851 Census, Jemima, a widow with hers and Roberts children is living at the same address as Joseph and Elizabeth Steward; Joseph is her brother-in-law. Thus it appears that Robert passed away shortly before the 1851 Census. No death records have yet been found for him. Robert has also not been found in the 1841 Census.

For the 1861 Census, Jemima, unmarried is living with her children. It was hoped that for 1861 there might be some other family members. However, there was none.

## 1861 Census Notes

An attempt has been made to reproduce all data exactly as it is on the original census record; some column heading wording changes have been made for brevity.

1. If you wish to explore any of this data further, please contact Dave directly.
2. The family name is Steward but shown as Stewart in the 1861 Census.
3. Based on Baptismal Records, daughter Jemima Mary was born 26 March 1846 and Louisa was born 26 April 1848 to Robert and Jemima Steward.
4. The 1851 Census Record showed a daughter Susan, but no baptismal record was found nor is she listed in the 1861 record. It is the likely the daughter Susan in the 1851 Census is actually Louisa Steward.
5. The mystery child is Henry Stewart, age 7 and born about 1853-54. This is after Jemima was shown as a widow in the 1851 Census. It would appear that Henry was born out-of-wedlock, but there are other possibilities.
6. As of January 2010, no death date for a Robert Steward in the 1848-1851 timeframe in Poplar has been found, though it is possible he died elsewhere.

Joseph John Steward was born about 1825 in Poplar, England. His parents were John and Sarah Steward. Joseph John Steward ascends from our Scholdberg and Jordan lines. Joseph John Steward married Elizabeth Holloway in Poplar, England on 11 June 1848 at St. Mary's Stratford Bow, Bow, County of Middlesex in England.

To date, the 1861 Census for Joseph and Elizabeth Steward have not been found, though extensively searched for. However, a blank record, linked above has been inserted should one be found.

Joseph John Steward died 23 October 1892 in Poplar and thus the 1891 Census Record is his last. In August 1893, his wife Elizabeth Steward joined her daughter and two grandsons as they emigrated to America and Chicago in particular. Elizabeth Steward is then listed as part of your daughter, Elizabeth Jordan's household for the 1900 Chicago Census.

### 1851 Census Notes

An attempt has been made to reproduce all data exactly as it is on the original census record; some column heading wording changes have been made for brevity.

1. The above census data was found in a March 2004 search by Dave Jordan at the Family History Library in Salt Lake City.
2. The data shows three families living at 12 Chrisp Street in Poplar on the night of 30th March 1851.
3. It is certain that the first family is the Joseph and Elizabeth Steward family, although the name is shown as James instead of Joseph. More below on why this is so.
4. The second family is the Charles and Emma A. Hooper family. On his birth registration, one month old Charles Steward is shown as "Charles Hooper Steward." At first it we thought that Emma might have been a sister to Joseph Steward, but research by Diane Cusiell indicates that Emma's maiden name was not Steward. In 2006 Diane wrote that she had found a marriage of Charles Hooper and Emma Agnes Emblem on Free BMD – September Quarter 1841 in Shoreditch. She also wrote that there is a death of a Emma A. Hooper in September 1866 in Stepney, aged 44, which would match going by her age on the 1851 census. Thus it appears that Emma A. was Emma A. Emblem before she married Charles Hooper.
5. Thus Charles and Emma Hooper were probably Charles Hooper Steward's baptismal sponsors and/or good friends of his parents. And as a result Charles Steward (1851) was thus named Charles Hooper Steward after a close friend of the Joseph and Elizabeth Steward family.
6. The third family is the 1851 Census listing at 12 Chrisp Street is the Jemima Steward family. Jemima was the widowed wife of Robert Steward, older brother of Joseph Steward (shown in this record as

James Steward). Robert Steward died between 1848-1851. The baptismal index shows a Jemima Mary Steward born 26 March 1846; baptized 17 November 1850 at All Saints Poplar to Robert Melbourne Steward and Jemima Mary Steward. Robert and Jemima Mary had another daughter Louisa Steward born 26 April 1848; baptized 17 November 1850 at All Saints Poplar. As Louisa would have been 2 years old on 30 March 1851 it is likely that the child Susan listed in 1851 above is actually Louisa. Furthermore no Susan Steward for this timeframe has been found in the Parish Records.

7. As of January 2010, no death date for a Robert Steward in the 1848-1851 timeframe in Poplar has been found, though it is possible he died elsewhere.
8. Additional interpretations for the Joseph and Elizabeth Steward family is as follows:
9. Ages of 23 for Joseph (James) and Elizabeth suggest years of birth of 1827-1828, which is consistent with the data in subsequent census.
10. It is known that Elizabeth Priscilla Holloway Steward was born 27 February 1847 and was thus 4 years old, which matches Elizabeth Steward in the above record. Elizabeth is clearly shown as daughter to the "Head" and not "adopted daughter" or "mother's daughter" or the like. And her surname is clearly Steward. Both these entries thus strongly suggest our Elizabeth was the daughter of Joseph Steward, the man Elizabeth Holloway married 11 June 1848, some 16 months after Elizabeth's birth.
11. Young Joseph Steward was born 18 June 1849. He was really only one, but it looks like they round up to two.
12. Charles Hooper Steward was born 27 February 1851 at 12 Chrisp Street in Poplar. The age of 1 month and a Street location of 12 Chrisp Street are a perfect match with this 1851 Census record.

1. The above census data was found in a January 1988 search at the Genealogical Library, Salt Lake City by a genealogy researcher commissioned by Dave Jordan.
2. This record was found in January 1988 through a house-by-house search of a section of Poplar, England focused around Wade Street, East India Dock Road, West East India Dock Road and Poplar High Street. The Microfilm Reels searched are located at the Genealogical Library in Salt Lake City, Utah and are numbered: 824896 and 824897. The data transcribed was found on reel number 824897. All Steward, Jordan, Scholdberg and Holloway names and variations were searched. In the search, a number of other Stewards were found, but no Holloways, Jordans, or Scholdbergs. In 1993, a search of the indexes completed at that time by Clive Ayton was searched for Holloway, Scholdberg, and Steward. There were no Scholdberg matches. There were a few other Steward and Holloway matches.

An attempt has been made to reproduce all data exactly as it is on the original census record; some column heading wording changes have been made for brevity.

1. The above census data was found in a March 1987 search at the Genealogical Library, Salt Lake City by a genealogy researcher commissioned by Dave Jordan.
2. This record was found in March 1987 through a house-by-house search of a section of Poplar, England. The search was focused around Wade Street, East India Dock Road, West East India Dock Road and Poplar High Street. The Microfilm Reel searched is located at the Genealogical Library in Salt Lake City, Utah and is numbered: 1341113, enumeration districts 13-20, RG111508. All Steward, Jordan, and Holloway names and variations were searched. None other than those shown were found. An attempt has been made to reproduce all data exactly as is indicated on the original record; however, column headings have in some cases been shortened.
3. Finding this census record was a major discovery because it provided the original surname of James Oscar Jordan and Charles Jordan. From the Scholdberg name, it was then possible to find James Oscars' and Charles' original birth registrations and also to find their mother's marriage registration to Knut Scholdberg.
4. A mystery is the absence of information for the parents of the three grandchildren. By then Elizabeth Priscilla Scholdberg had re-married and was then Elizabeth Priscilla Jordan. An extensive search of the surrounding area was performed in an attempt to locate Elizabeth Jordan, James Jordan or Oscar Scholdberg. No listings have been found. Later it was found that Oscar Scholdberg had died in November 1875.
5. On the original 1881 census record, the street is written as 20 Wade Place while in the 1871 and 1891 it is written as 20 Wade Street. However, in the 1881 census the word Place is crossed out and there is a small St underneath it, which appears to be a correction to Wade Street. Wade Street is RG11/508, Folios 90-96 and Wade Place is RG11/508, Folios 88, 99, 102, 104-107. Preliminary data does not show a 20 Wade Place.
6. "Dock labourers were employed by means of a "call-on" at the dock gates twice daily. There was a trade depression during the 1890s and men were called on or paid off at any time of the day. They were employed literally by the hour at a rate of 5d. per hour (4d. at Tilbury). In 1889 the docker's struck to get the "docker's tanner", i.e. 6d. per hour. The great dock strike began at the East and West India Docks on 14th August 1889 and ended on 15th September. The dockers got their 6d. an hour and 8d. an hour overtime. However, industrial unrest continued with blacklegs being brought in during strikes". [East of London Family History Society, Cockney Ancestor Publication No. 100, August 2003, extracted from an article by Jan

Penney Page 13.] The terminology 5d. represents 5 shillings. A shilling is 1/20 of a British pound.

An attempt has been made to reproduce all data exactly as it is on the original census record; some column heading wording changes have been made for brevity.

1. The above census data was found in November 1993 in a search by Marianne Garcher.
2. This record was found in November 1993 by Marianne Garcher who viewed a microfiche copy for all of Poplar at the Dayton LDS Family History library. Because of the number of people in Poplar at the time, no general search was done. Instead just one address, 20 Wade Street, was searched. Searches of nearby streets for Jordans, Holloways, and Scholdbergs also took place. Only this Steward record was found.
3. The record was re-found in 2010 by Dave Jordan in *Ancestry*. However, it does not show in the Ancestry indexes. It is best to search on RG 12/332 then scroll to Folio 32, Page 10.
4. For the 1881 census, the three grandchildren: Oscar Scholdberg, Charles Scholdberg, and James Henry Jordan, were staying with Joseph and Elizabeth Stewards at 20 Wade Street. Sometime between 1882 and 1886, Oscar Scholdberg, aka James Oscar Jordan had left for Chicago. Then in late 1892, Joseph Steward died. And in 1893, Elizabeth Priscilla Jordan, Elizabeth Steward, Charles Jordan (formerly Charles Scholdberg), and James Henry Jordan left for America. It was hoped that the 1891 Census would shed light on whether Charles changed his name to Jordan while in England or upon the emigration to Chicago. It was also hoped that information on James Jordan, the husband of Elizabeth Priscilla Jordan could be found since so little was known about him. Unfortunately, little progress was made on these mysteries. Marianne Garcher searched nearby streets but to no avail. So the mystery remains on where and when James Jordan was born. And also why eleven year old James was again staying with his grandparents and not his mother and now where 17 year old Charles Jordan was.
5. Son Henry Steward and indicated as married appears to be visiting his parents on Census night. He married Mary Ann Smith on 8 March 1881 in Bethnal Green. His wife and family, including a son named William may be in Poplar or Bethnal Green for the 1891 Census.
6. A stevedore is person employed in the loading and unloading of ships.
7. Based on the 1871, 1881, 1891, and 1900 censuses, the possible years of birth for Elizabeth are January 1825, 1826 or 1830. For Joseph, his year of birth would be between 1824 and 1828.

Oscar Scholdberg died in 15 November 1875. Elizabeth Priscilla Holloway Steward Scholdberg then married James Oscar Jordan on 16 November 1875 at St. Mary's Stratford Bow, Bow, County of Middlesex in England.

Note that there are **Jordan named descendants** listed in the *Scholdberg Family Genealogy*. These Jordans descend biologically from the Scholdberg line and normally would have carried the Scholdberg name. However when Elizabeth Priscilla Scholdberg remarried in 1876 after Knut Scholdberg's death in 1875, her two young boys began using the surname of her 2<sup>nd</sup> husband, which was *Jordan*.

1. Elizabeth Priscilla Holloway Steward married twice. Her first marriage was to Knut Oscar Scholdberg. After Oscar Scholdberg died in November 1875 she married James Jordan in November 1876.
2. Elizabeth Priscilla's Scholdberg's sons Oscar and Charles changed their surnames to Jordan some time after her marriage to James Jordan. ## Oscar and Elizabeth P. Steward Scholdberg's Census Records

Elizabeth Priscilla Holloway Steward was born 27 February 1847 in Poplar, England. Her parents were Joseph and Elizabeth Steward, though at the time of her birth she was named Elizabeth Priscilla Holloway as her mother was unmarried. Elizabeth Priscilla Holloway Steward ascends directly from our Scholdberg and Jordan lines.

Elizabeth Priscilla Holloway Steward married Knut Oscar Scholdberg on 24 May 1867 at St. Mary's Stratford Bow, Bow, England.

Oscar Scholdberg died 15 November 1875. Elizabeth Priscilla Holloway Steward Scholdberg then married James Oscar Jordan on 16 November 1875 at St. Mary's Stratford Bow, Bow, County of Middlesex in England.

1. Both Dwelling Number and Family Number are artificial numbers used by the census enumerator.
2. The above census data was found in an October 1976 search by Dave Jordan at the National Archives. The record was located through the use of the Soundex system.
3. James Jordan's year of birth should have been 1868; Margaret's month of birth should have been April.
4. The number of marriage years agree with December 30, 1896.
5. James Jordan's father was born in Sweden. Margaret's father was born in Ireland; although her mother might have been born in Canada. It appears that the data for Herbert Jordan's parents place of birth is reversed.
6. James' naturalization is listed as "alien".
7. Margaret did immigrate from Canada with her parents in the late 1880s. Perhaps her naturalization is listed as unknown because she was unsure or perhaps she wasn't around and James provided the information. An attempt has been made to reproduce all data exactly as it is on the original census record; some column heading wording changes have been made for brevity.

1. Both Dwelling Number and Family Number are artificial numbers used by the census enumerator.
2. The above census data was found in a June 30, 1988 search by Dave Jordan at the Allen County Library, Fort Wayne, Indiana. The record was located through the use of the Soundex/Miracode system.
3. As in the 1900 Census, James O. Jordan indicates the birthplace of his father as England, but it is believed to be Sweden.
4. Muriel Woodbury was the sister of Margaret. She was born Muriel Knowles and later would remarry to become Muriel Leonhardt.
5. Sisters Margaret and Muriel indicate their father's birthplace as Scotland. In subsequent census Margaret switches to Ireland, which is correct. Their father William was a strong advocate of his Scottish Ancestry, but the Scottish ancestry was before his own father lived in Northern Ireland.
6. In 1920, the 1910 boarder Robert Graham would become the second husband of Margaret Jordan.
7. It is difficult to read the naturalization status of Robert Graham, it is possible that the script indicates "No" and not "Na".
8. James Oscar Jordan indicates his year of immigration as 1882 in this census versus 1886 for the 1900 census.
9. Margaret and Muriel have immigration dates one year apart. This might be true if her their father brought some of the family first.

## 1940 Census Notes

An attempt has been made to reproduce all data exactly as it is on the original census record; some column heading wording changes have been made for brevity.

1. The above census data was found in an October 2012 search by Dave Jordan.
2. James Oscar Jordan was born February 15, 1868 and was age 72 not 70.
3. The H-2 designation indicates that James Oscar Jordan had completed 2 years of High School.
4. James Jordan indicated that he was a widow, but his former wife Margaret Graham lived until 1959. It is possible he did not know or found it convenient to claim widowhood. He was actually divorced.
5. The "Same Place" for residence in 1935 means that James Oscar Jordan lived in Chicago.
6. It is thought that James Oscar Jordan received a pension from his work at the Conway Building after he retired, thus the entry for receiving \$50 or more from other sources.
7. Monthly rental of \$25 for Mrs. Esterline seems pretty low compared to other locations at the time. It was likely a small place and James Oscar would have paid a fraction of that for his rental to her.
8. Because James Jordan was listed on line 68, there were additional questions. He stated that his father and mother were born in England. However, it is now known that his father was born in Sweden. His father died when he was 7 years old and his mother married a Jordan. Other data collected over the years implies he did not know his father's surname. It is possible he did not know that he was not English either. The English father entry is consistent with the same entries for the 1900 and 1910 Census.
9. Line 68 also indicates that James O. Jordan did not have a Social Security Number. This is a little curious as he claims he was naturalized and he worked at the Conway Building as an electrician for decades.

## Margaret J. Jordan/Graham's Census Records

James Oscar Jordan was born as Joseph Canute Oscar Scholdberg on 18 February 1868 in Poplar, England. His parents were Knut Oscar and Elizabeth Priscilla Holloway Steward Scholdberg. Sometime after his mother married James Jordan (shortly after Knut Oscar Scholdberg's death) in 1876, Oscar Scholdberg began using the new surname and adopted name of his step-father.

James Oscar Jordan married Margaret Jane Knowles on 30 December 1896 in Chicago, Illinois. They were separate in November 1911. Margaret lived on her own and raised the five children. On June 19, 1919 the divorce with James Oscar Jordan was finalized and she married Robert Aaron Graham one year later on June 28, 1920 in Chicago, Illinois. In the early 1920s, Robert and Margaret and some of the children moved to California.

1. Both Dwelling Number and Family Number are artificial numbers used by the census enumerator.
2. The above census data was found about 1995 in a search by Marianne Garcher at the Allen County Library, Fort Wayne, Indiana. The record was located through the use of the Soundex system.
3. In this record, Margaret corrects the error of the 1900 and 1910 censuses and indicates her father's birthplace as Ireland which is correct. She also indicates her mother's birthplace as Ireland instead of Canada as indicated in the 1900 and 1910 censuses. It is not known yet if this is correct, but she reverted back to Canada for the 1930 Census.
4. Son Charles Jordan is missing from Margaret's family. He did not marry until 1924. He would have been 16. It is not known if this was an oversight or if he was living somewhere else. He is definitely not on Margaret's 1920 Census record. Son Herbert Jordan was married and has his own census record.
5. Margaret was *divorced* not *widowed* at the time of the census. She had divorced June 19, 1919. Perhaps she was hesitant to indicate that she was divorced.
6. The birthplace of the father and mother of the children Frances, Edward, and Arthur appears reversed. The father was born in England and the mother (Margaret) was born in Canada.
7. Robert Graham was a roomer in the James and Margaret Jordan household during the 1910 Census and continues to be in Margaret's household for this 1920 Census even though it is at a different address. On June 28, 1920 he and Margaret were married in Chicago.
8. It was always said that Margaret was a piano player, organist at the Silent Movie Theaters. This record backs this up.

2. Frances F. Hollingshead was formerly Frances Florence Jordan, daughter of James Oscar Jordan and Margaret Jane Jordan (nee Knowles, now Graham). For this census, it appears she has used her middle name Florence as a first name.
3. Arthur O. Jordan was the son of James Oscar Jordan and Margaret Jane Jordan (nee Knowles, now Graham). For this census, it appear he has changed his middle initial to "O." In previous records it had been "S." The "O." is probably for Oscar. The meaning of the former "S" possibly was for "Scholdberg" or "Stanley."
4. Margaret J. Hollingshead appears to be named after her grandmother, Margaret Jane Graham (nee Knowles) and possibly Robert A. Jordan after his step grandfather Robert A. Graham.
5. The age indicated for Robert A. Jordan (3 years 10 month) matches his birth of June 22, 1926. The age indicated for Shirley L. Jordan (2 year 8 months) approximately matches her birth date of November 22, 1927, being off by about 4 months.
6. In this record, Margaret Graham indicates her mother's birthplace as Canada which she also did on the 1900 and 1910 Censuses. However, on the 1920 Census she indicated it was Ireland.. Her mother's birth records have not been found, but it is believed she was born in Quebec, Canada though it is not known if it was the city or the Province.
7. Margaret Graham indicates she is a Naturalized citizen. In the 1920 Census she indicated that she had her 1st papers. Thus she probably was naturalized shortly after 1920, probably in Illinois.

2. This Census indicates that Arthur S. Jordan was the owner of 6324 Klump Ave. His brother Herbert A. Jordan stayed at this address in 1942 when he was a Defense worker. Herbert A. Jordan and his wife Elizabeth then lived in this home from late 1943 until 1947. It is unknown whether they lived there with Art and his family or if Herbert bought it from him.
3. Arthur Jordan was born in 1904 and thus would have been age 35 as stated. The ages of the children are also correct.
4. The "Same Place" indicator for residence in 1935 means the Arthur Jordan family lived in Los Angeles in 1935.

## Charles Scholdberg Jordan's Census Records

Charles H. Jordan was born 30 September 1873 in Poplar, England. His parents were Knut Oscar and Elizabeth Priscilla Holloway Steward Scholdberg. Sometime after his mother married James Jordan (shortly after Knut Oscar Scholdberg's death) in 1876, Charles Scholdberg began using the new surname of his step-father, Charles Jordan.

Charles H. Jordan, referred to in these pages as Charles Scholdberg Jordan for clarity never married. Charles never married and he has been generally found with his mother or his grandparents in their census records.

## Elizabeth P. Steward Scholdberg Jordan's Census Records

Elizabeth Priscilla Holloway Steward was born 27 February 1847 in Poplar, England. Her parents were Joseph and Elizabeth Steward, though at the time of her birth she was named Elizabeth Priscilla Holloway as her mother was unmarried. Elizabeth Priscilla Holloway Steward ascends directly from our Scholdberg and Jordan lines.

Elizabeth Priscilla Holloway Steward married Knut Oscar Scholdberg on 24 May 1867 at St. Mary's Stratford Bow, Bow, County of Middlesex in England.

Oscar Scholdberg died in 15 November 1875. Elizabeth Priscilla Holloway Steward Scholdberg then married James Oscar Jordan on 16 November 1875 at St. Mary's Stratford Bow, Bow, County of Middlesex in England.

This section contains information about census searches that were made for the Jordan, Scholdberg and Steward family lines for four cities: Chicago, Madison, Wisconsin, Los Angeles, California and Poplar, England. Census searches were made for the city of Chicago for the years 1900, 1910, 1920, 1930 and 1940; for the city of Madison for 1910, 1920 and 1930; for the city of Los Angeles for 1930 and 1940, and for the town of Poplar, England for 1871, 1881 and 1891. Successful family household entries were found for the Elizabeth Priscilla Jordan, Hebert Arthur Jordan, James Oscar Jordan and other families in Chicago; the James H. Jordan family in Madison; the Graham and Jordan families in Los Angeles, and the Scholdberg and Steward families in London. Listed with heads of households are spouses, children, brothers, sisters, grandchildren and boarders.

### Chicago Census

The 1900, 1910, 1920, 1930 and 1940 Chicago Censuses can be located using the Soundex system. The Soundex System uses a phonetic method to organize surnames. The value of the Soundex system is that a name can be found relatively easily even if names were spelled differently than the way they are expected to be spelled. Unusual spellings occurred for several reasons including census takers not always being careful in accurately recording the spelling of our ancestors' names or that our ancestors did not always spell their names in a consistent way. Under the Soundex system, the surnames Jordan, Jorden, and Jordon would be placed together.

The 1890 Census was destroyed by fire. All Jordan and Steward families arrived after the 1880 Census and thus the first available census to search is the 1900 Census.

Access to the Chicago Census, as part of the total U.S. Census, is readily available at a number of locations. In particular, searches have been made over the years at the National Archives in Washington D.C., the National Archive Regional Branch in Bayonne, New Jersey, the National Archive Regional Branch in Chicago, the Newberry Library in Chicago, and the Allen County Library in Fort Wayne, Indiana.

Around the year 2000, the USA and UK census data became increasingly available on-line. By 2010 all USA and UK census information were available on-line via a number of websites and genealogy sites such as *Ancestry*, *Footnote* and *Find My Past*.

### Poplar, England Census

At the time of the initial searches, the 1871, 1881, and 1891 Censuses in England were not indexed thus a house-by-house search was performed. For the 1871 and 1881 census records, a searcher was retained to perform a house-by-house microfilm search of an area of Poplar, England focused around Wade Street. All recordings of the names: Jordan, Scholdberg, Scholdburg, Steward, and Holloway in the searched area were recorded.

For the 1891 Census, Marianne Garcher viewed a microfiche copy for all of Poplar at the Dayton LDS Family History library. Because of the number of people in Poplar at the time, no general search was done. Instead just one address, 20 Wade Street, was searched and it was successful. Searches of nearby streets for Jordans, Holloways, and Scholdbergs also took place, but no additional families with this name were found.

With the availability of on-line indexes to the 1871 Census by *Ancestry* and the 1851 Poplar Census index by the *East of London Family History Society*, additional finds were made for the Steward and Scholdberg families. In 2010 it was found in the Ancestry index that the 1891 listing was not under *Steward* but under *Stenard*, most likely a misreading of a *w* for an *n*.

For England, it was the practice to record all members of a household present on census night. For the 1871 census, this was the night of April 3. Thus if a member of a household were away on census night, they would not be recorded at their home address but instead somewhere else. In contrast, U.S. census data was collected over a period of several weeks; the goal being to identify permanent members of a household. The English method may explain why Oscar Scholdberg's parents were missing from the 1881 census and also the 1891 census.

### **Unsuccessful Census Searches**

Successful census searches for the various Jordan families are listed above. However, there were a number of unsuccessful searches that might be found someday. These are:

1. Charles and Elizabeth P. Jordan for the 1910 and 1930 Census
2. James Oscar Jordan for the 1920 Census and 1930 Census
3. Charles Steward for the 1910 Chicago Census and beyond.
4. James and Elizabeth P. Jordan for the 1881 and 1891 Censuses for Poplar and/or the East of London.

For the 1910 Census, a search for Elizabeth P. Jordan used three different search methods; none successful. These were:

1. a Soundex index search of Elizabeth Jordan for Illinois,
2. a general search for Madison, Wisconsin near her 1907 address, and
3. a house-by-house search of enumeration district 542 in Chicago including the 2049 W. 12th Street dwelling.
