Introduction

This document contains historic addresses of our Tansi and Vanderkloot ancestors and is available on *Our Vanderkloot Family Web Pages* as part of our Vanderkloot family history. This listing is restricted to deceased families or members of our Tanis and Vanderkloot family lines.

For ease of use, the above <u>*Table of Contents*</u> includes active links along with a simplified genealogy chart to assist in selecting items of interest. Merely touch the line or page number to move to a section of interest.

Following are *Historical Vanderkloot Family Addresses* for two family surnames that led to our current Jordans all of whom are part of *The Vanderkloot Story*. These *Addresses* begin with the Adrianus and Maatje Vanderkloot Family of Holland and include some of their descendants. After the Vanderkloot addresses, the Dirk and Cornelia Tanis Family of Holland is listed. One branch of each family led to our Vanderkloots of Chicago and later our Jordans of Chicago.

The key families are:

- 1. The Vanderkloot Family
- 2. The Tanis Family

Addresses were obtained from a number of sources including but not limited to *Baptism Records*, *Marriage Records*, *Census Records*, *and Death Records*, *and City Directories*. The resulting *Address Records* listing thus represents a chronology that show when and where various events took place during the lives of our ancestors.

The *Address Lists* are organized around families and thus the various records that are indexed in the above *Table of Contents* are titled by either the name of a family (husband and wife) or an individual if unmarried including widow, widower. Addresses for husband and wife before marriage can be found with their parents. Included also is a section which provides descriptions and locations of the various cities and neighborhoods associated with our ancestors.

Spellings of names and places vary for different records and sometimes individuals changed some part of their names or used nicknames or abbreviations. In the transcriptions that follows, the names are transcribed as they were recorded in the original record source.

In order to help preserve our family history and to make that history more widely available, *Our Vanderkloot Family Web Pages* was created in the early years of the 21st century.

While quite successful in its goals, it became clear with the passage of time, that a web site with many hundreds of pages was not easy to print or to electronically download. Thus in the later part of the first decade of the 21st century, I began to compile various categories of information such as Vanderkloot Family Addresses, Vanderkloot Family Census Records, Vanderkloot Genealogy Source Records, and the Vanderkloot Stories into pdf documents.

Such pdf files will make it easier to download files for preservation on our many computers and they will also allow much easier printing of pages and for studied analysis as desired. As part of this effort, a *Vanderkloot and Tanis PDF Downloads* web page was created. From this page, all currently available pdf's from *Our Vanderkloot Family Web Pages* and out *Our Tanis Family Web Pages* can be accessed.

You are encouraged to download the various Vanderkloot and Tanis pdf files, not only for your own study but to also help preserve for future generations hard to obtain data and information about our common Vanderkloot and Tanis origins and history. Files are updated every once in a while, and checking about once a year is a reasonable frequency. Version dates are shown at the beginning of the *Table of Contents*.

You may have noted that the current document is quite lengthy and contains information for not only the Vanderkloot but also the Tanises. While it might have made sense to focus this document on one family or a family line with the same surname, my worry was that there would have been a proliferation of pdf files. Many scattered files and associated updates would make it harder to find and save all the related and connected information. Thus all have been placed within the current file.

City and Neighborhood Locations and Descriptions

As follows are descriptions and locations of various cities, towns, and neighborhoods in Noord Holland, Zuid Holland, Zeeland, Noord Brabant, and Illinois connected with the history of our Tanis and the Vanderkloot families.

Noord Holland

As follows are text descriptions of towns and locations in Noord Holland related to our Tanis and Vanderkloot families. The Island of Texel is located in Noord Holland.

Anna Paulowna Polder

Anna Paulowna is in North Holland about 5 miles south of Den Helder the gateway to Texel. It is about 33 miles north of Amsterdam. The population in 1970 was around 7500. Before 1870 Anna Paulowna was part of the municipality of Zijpe. According to the Texel Population Registers, Adrianus van der Kloot, son of Matthijs van der Kloot, went there from Texel on July 13, 1877. He would have been 25 years old. He must not have stayed long, because he left for America in October 1881. Given its location and ferry service to Texel across the Marsdiep he could have easily visited his family in Cocksdorp.

Bland and Berg Farm, Eierland, Texel

This was the farm that Dirk and Cornelia Tanis lived from about 1840 when they arrived in Texel and grew madder until 1866 when they moved into a house. After Cornelia died, Dirk moved back there with his son Dirk Dirksz and his wife Antje. Before 1843, the farm was called Siberie. It appears that Dirk and his son Dirk Dirksz and his wife Antje never owned the farm but were tenants that worked the land. All six children of Dirk and Cornelia (Cornelis, Dirk Dirksz, and Art Dirksz, along with the daughter whose name is unknown that married a Dros would have lived here while growing up. On a map of Texel, there is a place called Bland en Berg on a road about 3.75 km (2.3 miles) southwest of De Cocksdorp on the road called Postweg. It is about 3/4 km south of the Oorsprongweb intersection on the east side of Postweg. There is a good chance this is the location.

De Cocksdorp, Texel

From an October 18, 1977 letter from E. Th. R. Unger on behalf of the Rijksarchivaris in Noord-Holland , he states:

"The history of De Cocksdorp can be narrated in a few words: De Cocksdorp has been founded in 1835, shortly after the reclamation of the Eijerland-polder. The village was named after Nicholas Josephus de Cock, a trader from Rotterdam, one of the money lenders. In 1841 (according to the "Aardrijkskundig Woordenboek der Netherlanden" by A. J. van der Aa, published in Gorinchem in 1841) the village consisted of 20 dwellings, housing 120 inhabitants (at present day the inhabitants number 1000 at most). In 1839 a Dutch-Reformed church was built and in 1841 a Roman-Catholic church".

All the children of Matthijs and Trijntje van der Kloot except Adrianus were born in De Cocksdorp. De Cocksdorp was the new town created on the Eijerland Polder. The original blacksmith shop and house in De Cocksdorp is still be standing. The address is: Kikkertstraat 47. However, it is no longer a blacksmith shop and house. The large Roggesloot Canal is just to the east and likely where the family ice skated in the 1850s and 60s. The town is still a small village but in summertime a number of tourists come to partake in the good access to the beaches.

Eijerland Polder, Texel

From a June 4, 1977 letter from E. Th. R. Unger on behalf of the Rijksarchivaris in Noord-Holland , he states:

"... Texel and Eijerland, being two separate islands, were joined together by a dike in 1629/1630 (the Zanddijk; between the farm "Prinsenhage" and the Duinweg. This combination was continually increased by reclamation. The polder Eijerland (also Eijelandsche polder) came into being in 1835. "

The opening of the Eijerland Polder significantly increased the size of the Island of Texel on the northern end. It was here that Adrianus and Maatje van der Kloot and family migrated to after 1835. This was also where Dirk and Cornelia Tanis and family migrated also after 1835. Adrianus van der Kloot, the first child of Matthijs and Trijntje Vanderkloot was born here on April 16, 1852."

Haarlemmermeer

Haarlemmermeer (Harlem Lake) is a polder about 6 miles southeast of Harlem and about 10 miles from Amsterdam and is an agricultural area. Haarlemmermeer had been ruined by destructive floods in the 16th century and was finally reclaimed about 1852. Martha Tanis was born here on March 28, 1857. Adrianus van der Kloot died here on November 19, 1874 and his wife Maatje Dominé van der Kloot died here on September 12, 1888.

Polder

A polder is a body of low-lying land that has been claimed from a body of water and is protected by dikes.

Texel

Texel is an island a few miles off the northwest coast of the Netherlands and is the largest and southernmost of the West Frisian Islands. Originally, Texel and Eijerland were two separate islands but were joined by a dike in 1629/1630. This connection was continually increased by reclamation until the land came into being in 1835, almost 200 years later, the entire project approximately doubling the size of the lower island to about 20 miles with the width at about 10 miles. Texel is sometimes spell Tessel, thus suggesting how it is pronounced. The seven main villages on the island are: De Cocksdorp, Oosterend, De Waal, Oudeschild, Den Hoorn, Den Burn, and Den Koog. As of 1995 there were no van der Kloots in the Texel Telephone Directory. Today the island has about 15,000 residents but this may swell to two or three times during the summer including the tourists. It is a bit hillier than the mainland and there are many bike paths. The main access to Texel is via a ferry from Den Helder which can be reached via train. It is my understanding that there are taxi tours once the ferry arrives in Texel. These can be taken to see an overview of the island.

Zijpe

Zijpe is in North Holland about 5 miles south of Den Helder the gateway to Texel. It is about 33 miles north of Amsterdam. After 1870, the municipality of Anna Paulowna split off. Kleine Sluis is within Zijpe. The railway appears to run very close to Kleine Sluis and Anna Paulowna on its way to Den Helder. Trijntje Smit was born here on May 2, 1832 and family history indicates it was in Kleine Sluis. This is also where she married Matthijs van der Kloot on November 15, 1851.

Zuid Holland

As follows are text descriptions of towns and locations in Zuid (South) Holland related to our Tanis and Vanderkloot families. Our Tanis and Vanderkloot families lived here before migrating to Texel in the mid-1830s.

Island of Goeree-Overflakkee

The Island of Goeree-Overflakkee borders the Noord Zee (North Sea) to the West and rivers surround it on the others sides. It appears there were originally two islands that were combined. Goeree is further west and is smaller. Overflakkee is the eastern part. The island is about 130 miles south of the Island of Texel.

Middelharnis, Island of Goeree-Overflakkee

Middelharnis is the main village on Overflakkee and during World War II the island became flooded. Maatje Dominé was born in Middelharnis on January 6, 1804 and Matthijs van der Kloot was born here on January 8, 1827.

Ouddorp, Island of Goeree-Overflakkee

Ouddorp is on the southern edge of the original Island of Goeree. Dirk Cornelis Tanis was born here in 1802 and returned here after many years in Texel. He died in Ouddorp in 1887. His son, Aart Dirksz Tanis, was born here on February 15, 1832.

Stellendam, Island of Goeree-Overflakkee

Stellendam is on the western edge of the original Island of Overflakkee. Dirkje Aletta Blaak was born here on September 27, 1836. Also this is the location Adrianus and Maatje were at when the contract was written for him to come to Cocksdorp.

Zeeland

As follows are text descriptions of towns and locations in Zeeland Holland related to our Vanderkloot families. Our Vanderkloot families lived here before migrating to Zuid Holland in the early 1800s.

Oud-Vossemeer, Island of Tholen

The island of Tholen, located in southwest Netherlands, is a medium sized island and is about 11 miles long and about 6 miles wide. It was basically an agricultural and fishing center. Adrianus van der Kloot was born here on January 19, 1798. It appears to be the origin of our van der Kloot line. Fred Vanderkloot has traced the line back in Oud-Vossemeer to the beginning of the 18th century.

Noord Brabant

de Kloot

The old town of de Kloot was located just north of 's-Hertogenbosch and is now part of it. It is speculated that this town may have been the origin of the families name. See Fred Vanderkloot's *Origin of the van der Kloot Name*. 's-Hertogenbosch (Duke's Forest") is about 80km south of Amsterdam and about 60 west of Oud-Vossemeer, the historic home of the van der Kloots.

Illinois

Chicago


In the 1880s, most of the Vanderkloots originally settled in a section of Chicago referred to as Southtown which includes an area south of Archer, north of about 23rd, east of Halsted and west of State. This area is also considered part of greater Bridgeport.

| Matthijs Vanderkloot's Home (1899-1912) | 2629 S. Union | 1. 2. 3. | 2629 S. Union is two blocks east of Halsted (1/8 mile) and about 150 feet south of 26th. It is on the east side of Emerald. Matthijs, Trijntje and Matthijs Jr., and John moved here around late 1898 or early 1899. John appears to have stayed until his death in 1910. Matthijs was still there in 1905. The 1900 Census indicates Matthijs rented this home. See picture in Vanderkloot Picture Collection. |
| Adrianus Vanderkloot's Home (1889-90) | 2623 S. Emerald | 1. 2. 3. | 2623 S. Emerald on the east side of Emerald. This is the earliest confirmed address for Adrianus and Martha. In 1889, it was across the street from where his mother and father lived. See picture in Vanderkloot Picture Collection. |
| Adrianus Vanderkloot's Home (1890-93) | 2626 Lowe | 1. 2. | 2626 Lowe is three blocks east of Halsted and on the west side of Lowe. Adrianus and Martha moved here in 1890. |
| Adrianus Vanderkloot's Home (1894-96) | 2834 S. Emerald | 1. 2. | 2834 S. Emerald on the west side of Emerald. This location is where my Grandmother Grace was born. |
| Adrianus Vanderkloot's Home (1899-1903) | 2851 S. Emerald | 1. 2. 3. 4. | 2851 S. Emerald on the east side of Emerald The 1900 Census indicates Adrianus rented this home. Chicago Street Numbering Overview

The following information and table have been put together to help convert street names into street numbers and vice versa for some of the old Chicago neighborhoods my ancestors lived.

Overview of Chicago Street Characteristics

- 1. In Chicago there are normally 8 streets per mile.
- 2. The addressing system then numbers each street west of State Street as multiples of 100 West.
- 3. However, in more congested areas there can be as many as 16 streets per mile. This is the case for a couple of miles west of State. In the table below are shown sixteen streets for the mile between State and Halsted. All these streets run north-south.
- 4. Over the years a number of these streets were renamed and in some areas the streets may not exist anymore due to added rail lines, parks, expressways.
- 5. There are also 8 streets to the mile for streets running east-west.
- 6. State and Madison are address reference point zero-zero.
- 7. As an example south 24th Street is 3 miles south of Madison and south 32nd Street is four miles south of Madison.
- 8. In congested areas, additional streets called "Place" such as 24th Place may be added. 24th Place would be between 24th and 25th Streets.
- 9. Addresses on north-south streets with an odd numbered address such as 3001 S. Emerald, are on the east side of the north-south street. Addresses on east-west streets with odd numbers such as 187 24th Place are on the south side of the street.

City Directories

Following is background on various city directories which were used to compile many of the addresses for our families of interest.

Chicago Directories

The Chicago City Directories list individuals and businesses in Chicago from the years 1839 to 1917 with special Directory editions in 1923 and 1928-1929. These directories, though rather comprehensive, are sometimes incomplete as many times newer immigrants and boarding house roomers were missed. Listings for each individual include name, address and occupation and business names if proprietor. The data were generally collected in the closing months before the year of publication; thus the addresses were sometimes out-of-date by publication since the population was very mobile.

The Chicago Public Library and the Newberry Library have most of the Chicago Directories on microfilm. The New York Public Library also has a fairly complete collection of these directories in their original paper form. Microfilms of the Chicago Directories may also be borrowed from various locations on interlibrary loan.
